Wyoming is frequently recognized as a top jurisdiction for locating trust and business assets. At the same time, the state offers many desirable features of a sophisticated trust jurisdiction, including a responsive legislature and court system, talented legal and accounting professionals and financial institutions (including chartered and unregulated trust companies) with both national and international clientele.

Wyoming has adopted the standard features of modern trust law, as well as a number of innovative tools that maximize the efficiency and flexibility of using trusts to manage wealth. These are set forth in a version of the Uniform Trust Code that has been heavily modified and supplemented to provide a full suite of modern trust tools, which continue to expand.
